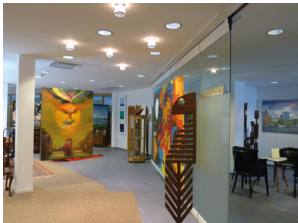


Every two years, Galerie KAM of Kulturaustausch Hamburg-Übersee e.V. offers, among other things, the juried, International Painting Biennale Hamburg on a given theme. The exhibition in 2020 „ENVIRNMENT IN ECOLOGY DISCOURSE: HYDROGEN“ was postponed to 2022 due to the corona pandemic. Four prizes are awarded by a panel of jurors: a sponsorship prize which is endowed with 2,500 Euros, and three special prizes in the form of hotel or other non-cash vouchers.

Hamburg's only castle is located in Bergedorf. The building was probably used in the 13th century as a moated castle on the river Bille and has been extended and renovated over the centuries. However, queens or princes have never lived here as Bergedorf Castle served as a purely administrative building to landowners, officials and later the Hamburg Senators responsible for Bergedorf. Today the castle houses the Museum of Bergedorf and Vierlande, which presents exhibitions on the history of Bergedorf as well as regional and international contemporary art.

The restaurant „In aller Munde“ (www.inallermunde.hamburg) completes the infrastructure.

The park adjacent to the castle which has been placed under a preservation order since 1926, serves as a recreation area for Bergedorf and is used by residents and tourists alike.
